In Slovakia



- Accreditation Committee as a state government advisory body operated since 1993
- 2013 ENQA Agency Review of former Accreditation Committee result: non-compliant, main issue – independence and others

Nature of Changes in Slovak HE



- From accreditation of individual study programmes to institutional responsibility
- From (state) accreditation to independent quality assurance
- From "auditing" to assurance and enhancement (ESG 2015), balanced involvement of stakeholders
- From formal evaluation to content peer reviews (a pool of reviewers)

Timeline for QA in Slovakia



• 2014-**2018**: preparation of a new legal framework

March 2019: SAAHE executive board

• 2019-2020: issuance of accreditation standards (criteria)

• 2020-2022: HEIs complying with standards

2020- study programme accreditation within ESG

2022 institutional internal systems of QA

• 2023-2024: initial institutional accreditation

- The first accreditation within the ESG compliant framework
- Application for ENQA Agency Review
- ENQA Review Panel site visit
- EQAR registration Committee
- ENQA Agency Review Committee and ENQA Board
- Application for WFME review

ENQA SEQA-ESG project (SAAHE)



- Six affiliates willing to comply ESG
 (Albania, Czech Republic, Malta, Moldova, Montenegro, and Slovakia)
- Initial meeting with ENQA, EQAR, Ministry and SAAHE (online cca 2021)
- National Action Plan (Ministry and SAAHE)
- Specialized workshops
- Progress visit (2022)

Approaching ENQA and EQAR



- ENQA Affiliate since 2021
- Application Letter to ENQA Feb. 2022 (earliest possible term)
- Preparation of Self-Assessment Report March-September 22
- Terms Of Reference agreement (ENQA, EQAR and SAAHE)
- Site visit of review panel March 2023
- ENQA review panel report published September 2023
- EQAR decision December 2023
- ENQA decision February 2024

 - Project SEQA-ESG, ENQA Leadership Programme
 - Learning from other agencies (staff mobilities, observers, best practice)
- Trainings/briefings
 - All stakeholders (HEIs, students and employers), incl. staff & reviewers
- Agency's strategic planning & rapid improvements
 - (internal PDCA cycles shortened & "asynchronous")
